



## TENURE-TRACK FACULTY POSITION STRATEGY - Undergraduate Programs

A PhD degree from a recognized school in a relevant discipline (entry-level candidates can be close to completion) is required. For all positions, proficiency in Spanish is a plus, but not required. Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Our Strategy faculty is known for its strong publication record, especially in areas related to strategic firm growth and size, such as organizational hierarchies, alliances, product strategies and diversification, platforms, and non-market strategies. They have published in journals like American Economic Review, Quarterly Journal of Economics, Management Science, Academy of Management Journal, Organization Science, Strategic Management Journal, amongst others. Its members have won prestigious research grants like the ERC Starting Grant and the Marie Skłodowska-Curie fellowship.
