



TENURE-TRACK FACULTY POSITIONS IN INFORMATION SYSTEMS

Applicants will have earned a PhD in a relevant discipline from a recognized school by the date of the appointment. Previous experience in teaching is a plus and Spanish proficiency is desirable, but not required. Salary for this position will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Preference will be given to candidates that complement our existing research strengths in the following (but not limited to) areas: IT strategy and innovation, e-business, smart cities, e-health, big data and business analytics, machine learning, cybersecurity, and emergent technologies (e.g., Blockchain, AI, VR/AR, IoT).
