ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Master in International Development

The Master in International Development is a unique example of partnership between the United Nations and a top-tier university. It provides a world-class training for junior and mid-level professionals that want to further develop their skills to tackle the complex challenges associated to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

The next cohort will commence in October 2023 and will graduate in July 2024. All sessions are conducted in English. The faculty is made up of high-level experts, many of them currently working for the United Nations, as well as top scholars in sustainable development. The student body is composed of young professionals with highly diverse backgrounds, experiences and nationalities.

The Master will make use of the most advanced learning methodologies. Lectures and debates will be complemented with simulations, multimedia exercises, team projects, competitions, practical workshops, asynchronous forums, interviews with global leaders, professional coaching sessions, etc. In addition, students will develop a consultancy project to address a specific real challenge posed by a partner organization.

The Master also includes, a **one-week immersion experience** in a large UN operation, where students will be able to observe in situ real opportunities and challenges that decision makers face. Travel from Spain, accommodation and other basic expenses related to this trip are covered by the tuition.
