

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE "BEST PRACTICES CORNER" OF THE ENLIGHTED VIRTUAL EDITION 2020

## PURPOSE OF THE CONTEST

Fundación Telefónica, IE University, Fundación Santillana and South Summit (hereinafter, the Organisation) and within the framework of the digital format of the **enlightED Virtual Edition 2020** event, Of which they are all co-organisers, are promoting this contest with the aim of providing an opportunity for its participants to share, with the rest of the educational community, the **latest practices in digital education** which have come about as a result of the confinement measures imposed by the Covid-19 virus. These practices will be shared through the **Best Practices Corner**, which will form part of enlightED Virtual Edition 2020.

This edition of **enlightED Virtual Edition 2020**, now in its third edition, will be organised as a worldwide conference gathering leading international experts in education, technology and innovation in order to share solutions to the challenges caused by Covid-19 in learning and employment in our societies, and to reach practical conclusions through a large-scale debate on education in the digital era.

The aim of this Contest is to recognise and provide visibility to those projects that have led to innovative projects to improve the educational and training environment, so that these may provide a response to some of the most pressing challenges or problems in education since 2020.

All the proposals to be presented at the Contest by its participants, and the Evaluation Committee, which will be formed by the Organisation, will select the best in the school, university and corporate areas, to be virtually presented at the **Best Practices Corner** at **enlightED Virtual Edition 2020**..

Participation in the Contest implies acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

## PERIOD OF THE CONTEST

Participation in the Contest will be from 29 June to 14 September 2020, both dates inclusive. The Organisation will contact the Participant selected by the Contest Evaluation Committee on 28 September 2020.

The selected participants will present their proposals between 19 and 23 October 2020, during a time slot between 4:30 p.m. and 7 p.m. The date and time for each selected participant will be communicated by the Organisation sufficiently in advance.

## PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Those participating in the Contest must be of legal age, either as individuals or forming part of a team, for which there is no maximum number of members.

The participants may reside in any country in the world and the proposals can be presented in Spanish, English or Portuguese.

Participation will be via a form, hosted on a web platform designed by the organisers for this purpose, accessible via the link <https://enlighted.education/> (hereinafter the "Website"), and the participants shall duly complete all the information or data requested on said form. This form will be used to describe the project/proposal presented to the Contest by the participants.

The projects presented must focus on any of the three topics covered by **enlightED Virtual Edition 2020**: Corporate training and entrepreneurship, primary and secondary education or higher education. Each participant will be able to enter this Contest with a single project, therefore, should they present several projects, only the first one submitted will be valid.

## EVALUATION COMMITTEE. SELECTION CRITERIA

The Organisation will form a Contest Evaluation Committee, which will be made up of professionals with experience/skills in the areas and topics covered by the Contest.

The deliberations of the Evaluation Committee will be confidential and their decision will be final. After analysing the proposal presented to the Contest, the Evaluation Committee will select which participants will be able to present their projects within the framework of **enlightED Virtual Edition 2020**.

When selecting the participants, the Evaluation Committee will use the following criteria, always weighing the use of technology:

- Creative benefit
- Systematisation
- Adaptation/contextualisation
- Impact/achievement
- Replicability extension

### SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

The Evaluation Committee will select a minimum of three projects to be presented virtually at the "Best Practices Corner" at **enlightED Virtual Edition 2020** for each category/topic area. As previously indicated, these topic areas are: corporate training and entrepreneurship, primary and secondary education, and higher education.

The selected participants will present their projects in virtual format, either live or recorded. The maximum time for each presentation will be 15 minutes. Within the framework of the "Best Practices Corner", participants will be able to debate or share experiences, as well as questions, with the participants at **enlightED Virtual Edition 2020**, through the virtual *networking* spaces, as well as enjoy the other activities scheduled at the event.

Similarly, the Evaluation Committee will be able to propose the inclusion of some of the projects presented to the Contest for publication.

### INTELLECTUAL AND INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Through their registration and by way of the acceptance of these Terms and Conditions, the participants of the Contest declare and guarantee before the Organisation that they are the authors and/or exclusive owners of the projects presented, as well as all the material of which they are comprised, or they have the appropriate authorisations from the third parties who are the owners of said materials, for the purposes of guaranteeing the uses described herein in favour of the Organisation. In the event of any claims by third parties, the participants agree to hold harmless the Organisation or any third parties authorised by the latter.

The participants selected authorise the Organisation collectively and individually with regard to each one of the entities that form it, on a non-exclusive basis and capacity to transfer to third parties, the reproduction, public communication, transformation and distribution rights, in all their formats, of the projects presented in the Contest, with a global scope and for the maximum period of protection provided for in the legislation in force until the entry into the

public domain of the said projects, but limiting such uses to non-free and non-commercial purposes, set out in the dissemination of the activities and purposes of the Organisation and **enlightED Virtual Edition 2020**.

In the event that during the Contest a claim is presented against any of the participants due to a breach of the intellectual property rights of third parties, or for the presentation of the project for which the Organisation or Evaluation Committee has well-founded doubts, said participant may be disqualified from the Contest.

### **PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION**

The Organiser undertakes not to process the personal data provided by the participants except for the purposes related to the organisation and selection of the Contest. The consent of the participants regarding the privacy policy of each one of the entities comprising the Organisation will be obtained When registering for the Contest via the Website..

The selected participants will be solely responsible for the veracity of the data provided.

### **ACCEPTANCE**

The Contest will be governed by these Terms and Conditions. The acceptance thereof by all the participants wishing to participate in the Contest is a condition precedent for participation.

With the acceptance of these Terms and Conditions, the participants understand the terms and conditions therein, and undertake to comply with the legislation in force that may be applicable in this regard, in such a manner by the simple fact of participating in the Contest they are granting their consent to be subject to the Terms and Conditions and to the legality thereof, fully and irrevocably, as well as the decisions of the Jury.

### **EXCLUSION AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY**

The Organisation is responsible for the organisation of the Contest and reserves the right to remove any participant that does not comply with the conditions established in these Terms and Conditions and/or which, Pursuant to the applicable legal provisions, Violates the rights of third parties or any other legislation of a civil, penal, administrative or any other nature, or which have provided false, inexact, incomplete or obsolete data.

The Organisation has the right to interpret and change these Terms and Conditions.

The Organisation is not liable for any possible loss of data due to problems with email and/or the poor functioning of the Internet and/or Website and, similarly, is exempt from any liability for damages and losses of any nature caused by the participation, as well as the damages and losses of any nature that may be suffered by the participants or third parties as a result of their participation in this Contest.

## **JURISDICTION**

In the resolution of any dispute or discrepancy that may arise in the interpretation or application of these Terms and Conditions, both the Organisation and the participants in the Contest expressly submit to the jurisdiction and courts of the Capital of Madrid, with express waiver of any other jurisdiction.

The participation in this Contest implies the full and complete acceptance of these legal Terms and Conditions detailed herein.

This Contest shall be subject to Spanish law.
