



LIST OF SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE FOR UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS AT IE UNIVERSITY

DIRECT AWARDS THAT DO NOT REQUIRE A SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

IE HIGH POTENTIAL AWARD

Application Deadline: Not applicable. These awards are not based on a scholarship application. All candidates admitted to an IE degree are automatically considered.

Geographic Area: All regions.

Programs: All programs.

Description: By applying for admission to IE, all applicants are automatically considered for this merit-based award and no scholarship application is required. The Admissions Department will identify candidates based on the strength and timeliness of their admission application, and will nominate them to the Scholarship Committee for an award. Candidates that qualify for this scholarship will be notified in the days following their admission offer.

Selection Criteria: These merit-based scholarships are determined without consideration of applicants' financial need. If the recipient of a direct award were to need more financial support, he or she would be eligible to submit a regular scholarship application.

Amount: No fixed amount. We offer several of these partial awards per intake. The amount will vary depending on the candidate's merit and available funding at the time of the admission.

SCHOLARSHIPS THAT REQUIRE AN APPLICATION THROUGH THE IE WEBSITE

IE - PARENTS "YOUNG TALENTED LEADERS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM"

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year and prior to March 30th.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: The "Young Talented Leaders Scholarships Program" is exclusively funded by generous donations to the IE Foundation from parents of IE University students. The aim of this grant is to improve access to IE University for outstanding students who excel both academically and personally by making sure their economic situation does not prevent them from achieving their goals.

Selection criteria: Candidates must demonstrate excellent academic performance and stand out in their personal endeavours, showing extremely high levels of commitment and motivation towards their professional future.

Amount: These scholarships cover 100% of tuition fees as well as other educational expenses, living costs and accommodation.

IE³ COLLABORATION AWARD

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: All programs.

Description: The IE³ Collaboration Award Scholarship offers financial aid to aspiring, talented individuals in exchange for their participation on a project at IE. This project could be related to a wide range of areas (admissions, marketing, academia, international development, communication, etc.). The project will be assigned by the Committee and will not be chosen by the student. When assigning the project, the committee will evaluate the candidate's experience and skills, as well as their professional aspirations. Once assigned, the student will sign a partnership agreement, which will establish their role in the project, the tasks they must carry out, the number of hours they must dedicate to the project, and the expected quality level of their work. The project allocation process will not only take into account the excellence of candidates, but also their experience and skills, which must match those required in a range of existing projects at IE.

Selection criteria: The Scholarship Committee will assess the candidate's admission process, professional background, entrepreneurial motivations and spirit, and financial need.

Amount: This scholarship covers up to 75% of tuition fees.

IE SCHOLARSHIP FOR GOOD ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: At IE University, we want to foster talent and make sure that a candidate's financial situation does not stop them from achieving their goals. Aiming to reward students for their academic achievements, this grant covers up to 75% of a few students' tuition fees - they must have high school (or equivalent) results of above an 8.5/10 and prove that they need economic support.

Selection criteria: Students must have an academic average of 8.5 / 10 (or the equivalent). Candidates who demonstrate that they have a complex economic situation will be given priority.

Amount: This scholarship covers up to 75% of tuition fees.

IE HIGH ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: Scholarship for candidates planning to study in one of our undergraduate programs who have an excellent academic record (high school or baccalaureate). The grant can cover up to 100% of a degree's tuition fees. In order to qualify for this grant, students must have an outstanding academic career over the course of their studies before enrolment at IE University. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to revise the financial aid awarded in the event that the grant requirements are not maintained.

Selection criteria: Students must have an academic average of 9.5 / 10 (or the equivalent in their education system). Candidates who demonstrate that they have a complex economic situation will be given priority.

Amount: This scholarship covers up to 100% of tuition fees.

IE PERSONAL EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: Scholarship for students of any IE program who stand out through their participation in extracurricular activities, such as sports, cultural activities, social projects, etc.

Selection criteria: In addition to the standard requirements for the Financial Aid Program, candidates must demonstrate excellence in a non-academic extracurricular activity (sports, the arts or a social project, etc.) or have particular achievements of the same type.

Amount: This scholarship covers up to 75% of tuition fees.

IE YOUNG ENTREPRENEURS SCHOLARSHIP

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year .

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: If ever there was a university fully committed to promoting entrepreneurial spirit, it's IE University. The IE Young Entrepreneurs Scholarship is directed toward candidates who are currently studying an IE University degree and have started an entrepreneurial or social project over the course of their studies.

Selection criteria: In addition to the standard requirements set by the Financial Aid Program, candidates must prove that they have shown initiative in creating or maintaining an entrepreneurial or social activity of their own accord.

Amount: This scholarship can cover up to 75% of a degree's tuition fees.

IE HUMANITIES SCHOLARSHIP

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: IE positions its educational commitment in a framework which focuses on the diversity of nationalities, cultures, and ideas; the entrepreneurial mindset; technological immersion for an innovative culture; and the study of humanities to understand the world. IE University considers the humanities one of its foundations and constantly promotes the intellectual and professional development of students who cultivate, study, and enjoy disciplines and fields such as history, philosophy, the art of public speaking, and literature, as well as the rich neighboring universe of culture and the arts. As part of this effort, IE Foundation sets aside a number of scholarships for undergraduate and graduate studies. Thanks to our educational approach based on the humanities, our students can benefit society with a different and constantly renewed perspectives of the world.

Selection criteria: In addition to a strong academic and/or professional background, candidates must demonstrate that they have participated publicly and regularly in activities related to the humanities (literary awards, small publications in their department or an academic journal, literary or arts clubs, cultural or aesthetic use of social media, debate clubs, professional activities at cultural institutions, photography, etc.). Recognition by means of awards will be viewed positively. Priority will be given to candidates with the greatest financial need.

Amount: This scholarship will cover up to 50% of the cost of tuition.

IE SCHOLARSHIP

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: This scholarship is intended for candidates with limited financial resources that stand out in the admission process whether for the result of their admission tests, their academic or professional careers, or their international perspective.

Selection criteria: The merits and potential of the applicant will be assessed, giving priority to economic difficulties in financing the program.

Amount: The amount of the scholarship awarded will depend on the available budget, the profile, and the specific circumstances demonstrated by the applicant.

IE SCHOLARSHIP FOR COUNTRIES IN SPECIAL SITUATIONS

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year.

Geographical area: Countries affected by special situations.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: One of the IE Foundation's main objectives is to promote the highest standards in education worldwide, recognizing that education is the fastest means for the development of societal welfare. Aware of this fact, the IE Foundation has a special commitment to countries experiencing challenging situations that limit their citizens' access to education and impede their social development as a result. An economic crisis, severe currency devaluation, and natural disasters, among others, are situations that can directly affect our candidates' personal career plans and lead them to feel obligated to put their professional and/or academic development on hold. The IE Foundation reserves a special scholarship fund for candidates who have been directly affected by these circumstances. The fund aims to mitigate the effects of these exceptional situations and thus contribute to the continued development of candidates' career plans.

Selection criteria: As well as the general requirements for Scholarship programs, the candidate must show that they have been directly affected by an exceptional situation in their country of residence as well as have a strong academic background.

Amount: The amount of the scholarship awarded will depend on the available budget, the profile, and the specific circumstances demonstrated by the applicant.

IE WOMEN IN STEM SCHOLARSHIP

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: Bachelor in Data and Business Analytics, Bachelor in Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence.

Description: This scholarship is specifically designed to support women who are interested in launching a career in STEM or STEM-related areas or already have experience in those fields.

Selection criteria: Women who are able to demonstrate interest in STEM or STEM-related fields (science, technology, engineering or math) may apply. Selection will be based on the candidate's academic and/or personal merit alongside their proven financial needs.

Amount: This scholarship covers up to 75% of tuition fees.

IE - MULTIPLE SIBLINGS FAMILY SUPPORT SCHOLARSHIP

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: Scholarship for students already admitted to IE University who have one or more siblings already studying at IE University.

Selection criteria: This scholarship is only available for candidates who have a brother and/or sister enrolled at IE University at the time of their application. The committee will take the students' academic record and economic need into consideration.

Amount: This scholarship covers up to 15% of tuition fees for all the years the siblings are enrolled together at IE University.

IE - INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) SCHOLARSHIP

Application deadline: Before the start of the first academic year and prior to March 30th.

Geographical area: All regions: Three scholarships will be awarded to a candidate from the following geographical areas: Africa-Europe-Middle East, North and South America, and Asia-Pacific. The fourth scholarship will be awarded to a candidate from any region who displays special financial needs.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: Scholarships are aimed at candidates who are pursuing studies in any of the centres from any of the previously mentioned geographical areas where the IB system is taught. Candidates must also display personal and academic excellence.

Selection criteria: As well as fulfilling the general requirements of the Scholarship Program, candidates must be studying towards an IB Diploma in any institution, which teaches in accordance with the IB system. Additionally, in order to qualify for financial aid, candidates must maintain an outstanding academic performance during their current course and future courses at IE University. Priority will be given to candidates with the greatest financial need. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to review such aid in the event that the scholarship requirements are not maintained.

Amount: 4 annual scholarships covering up to 75% of tuition fees.

IE- UNITED WORLD COLLEGES (UWC) SCHOLARSHIP

Application deadline: Before the start of the first academic year and prior to March 30th.

Geographical area: All regions. One scholarship will be awarded to a candidate from the Spanish UWC delegation and the other scholarship will be awarded to another candidate from any of the other international UWC delegations.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: The scholarship was designed by the IE Foundation in collaboration with The United World Colleges (UWC) to facilitate admission to IE for those candidates who are preparing for an IB diploma in any of the UWC member schools and display outstanding academic performances and personal achievements. The ideal candidate should exhibit an exceptional academic record, demonstrate aspirations to become a global professional in their chosen field of knowledge, and represent the core values of IE University: innovation, entrepreneurial spirit, and interest in Humanities.

Selection criteria: As well as the general requirements for Scholarship Programs, candidates must have a strong academic background.

Amount: 2 annual scholarships covering up to 100% of tuition fees.

IE- QUEEN RANIA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FOR WOMEN LEADERS

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first year and prior to March 30th.

Geographical area: This scholarship is only for women that hold a Jordanian passport and are permanent residents in Jordan when they apply.

Programs: All Bachelor programs at IEU.

Description: IE Foundation and the Queen Rania Foundation want to support the academic development of Jordanian women with notable personal achievements by guaranteeing that economic circumstances do not stop them from obtaining their goal.

Selection criteria: This scholarship is exclusively for women with Jordanian passports who are residing in Jordan when they apply for the scholarship. Candidates academic record, personal and academic achievements, and demonstrable economic need will be assessed.

Amount: 3 annual scholarships covering up to 40% of tuition fees.

IE - CLIFFORD CHANCE FOR DIVERSITY

Application deadline: Before the start of the first academic year and prior to March 30th.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) at IE University.

Description: Thanks to the partnership between IE Foundation and Clifford Chance, each year a student with an outstanding academic profile and a clear international vocation will be selected to receive this scholarship. The

recipient of the scholarship will receive an aid of up to 50% off of their tuition fees and will have the opportunity to network with representatives of Clifford Chance.

Selection criteria: The scholarship is designed for candidates who demonstrate academic excellence and an international spirit and wish to study the Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) at IE University. Apart from the general requirements for the Scholarship Program, candidates should indicate on the application those aspects of their profile which stand out in one way or another and which demonstrate their international spirit.

Amount: 1 annual scholarship covering up to 50% of tuition fees.

IE – CUATRECASAS, GONÇALVES PEREIRA FOR INNOVATIVE LAWYER

Application deadline: Before the beginning of the student's first academic year and prior to March 30th.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) at IE University.

Description: Thanks to a partnership between IE Foundation and Cuatrecasas, Gonçalves Pereira, every year a student with outstanding results and an innovative spirit is selected to receive this scholarship. The student receives a grant that covers up to 50% of their tuition fees. They will also have the opportunity to network with representatives of Cuatrecasas, Gonçalves Pereira.

Selection criteria: This grant is directed toward candidates who are applying for the Bachelor of Laws (LL.B) at IE University and demonstrate academic excellence along with an innovative spirit. In addition to the standard requirements set by the Financial Aid Program, the student's application must highlight their innovative spirit.

Amount: 1 annual scholarship covering up to 50% of the cost of the program will be awarded.

IE – LATHAM & WATKINS ENTREPRENEURIAL LAWYERING

Application deadline: Before the start of the first academic year and prior to March 30th.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) at IE University.

Description: Thanks to the partnership between IE Foundation and the Latham & Watkins Firm, each year a student with an outstanding academic profile and an entrepreneurial spirit will be selected for this scholarship. The scholarship's recipient will receive an aid of up to 50% off of their tuition fees and will also have the opportunity to network with representatives of Latham & Watkins.

Selection criteria: The scholarship is designed for candidates who demonstrate academic excellence and a strong personal work ethic and wish to study the Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) degree at IE University. Aside from the general requirements for the Scholarship Program, candidates should indicate on the application those aspects of their profile which demonstrate their worthiness as a candidate and the achievements they have accomplished due to their previous endeavours.

Amount: 1 annual scholarship covering up to 50% of the tuition fees.

IE – PÉREZ-LLORCA FOR EXCELLENCE IN LAW PRACTICE

Application deadline: Before the start of the first academic year and prior to March 30th.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) at IE University.

Description: Thanks to the partnership between IE Foundation and the Pérez-Llorca Firm, each year a student with an outstanding academic profile and an aspiring outlook on personal growth, which has helped them to shine in areas beyond academia, will be selected for this scholarship. The scholarship's recipient will receive an aid of up to 50% off of their tuition fees and will also have the opportunity to network with representatives of Pérez-Llorca.

Selection criteria: The scholarship is designed for candidates who demonstrate academic excellence and a strong personal work ethic and wish to study the Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) degree at IE University. Aside from the general

requirements for the Scholarship Program, candidates should indicate on the application those aspects of their profile which demonstrate their worthiness as a candidate and the achievements they have accomplished due to their previous endeavours.

Amount: 1 annual scholarship covering up to 50% of the tuition fees.

IE - PWC FOR GLOBAL LAWYER

Application deadline: Before the start of the first academic year and prior to March 30th.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) at IE University.

Description: Thanks to a partnership established between the IE Foundation and PwC, every year a student with outstanding academic results and international aspirations is selected for this scholarship. The student chosen will receive a grant, which will cover up to 50% of their tuition fees and provide an opportunity to network with representatives of PwC.

Selection criteria: The grant is directed toward candidates who are applying to study a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) at IE University and demonstrate academic excellence and a clear vocation for an international career. In addition to the standard requirements set by the Financial Aid Program, the candidate's application must display interest and vocation for an international career.

Amount: 1 annual scholarship covering up to 50% of tuition fees.

IE- URÍA MENÉNDEZ FOR LEGAL PRACTICE AND THE HUMANITIES

Application deadline: Before the start of the first academic year and prior to March 30th.

Geographical area: All regions.

Programs: Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) at IE University.

Description: Thanks to the partnership between IE Foundation and Uría Menéndez Firm, every year one student, who demonstrates academic excellence and a special interest in the humanities, will be selected for this scholarship. The recipient of the scholarship will receive an aid of up to 50% off of their tuition fees and will have the opportunity to network with representatives of Uría Menéndez.

Selection criteria: The scholarship is designed for candidates who demonstrate academic excellence and interest in the Humanities and wish to study the Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) at IE University. Aside from the general requirements for the Scholarship Program, candidates should indicate on the application those aspects of their profile which stand out in one way or another and demonstrate their interests in the Humanities.

Amount: 1 annual scholarship covering up to 50% of tuition fees.
