




And, despite the disruption caused by the pandemic, the Foundation has never failed in its efforts to advocate for progress—on the individual level, within the academic community and in society as a whole.





Looking back at the various initiatives undertaken in 2020, I would like to focus on activities that came into being during the year, such as the IE Resilience Scholarship Fund, which aimed to lend a helping hand to the students and families most affected by the health crisis and the resulting economic downturn.

Many thanks to all of you who contributed to the Fund, including alumni, staff, professors (some of whom gave up elective course income to donate to the Fund); and parents of students, including one donor who asked to remain anonymous and who donated €150,000 to this Fund, which has helped numerous students.

We should also mention the new scholarships funded by Cubico Sustainable Investments and Celsia, and the expansion of the Santander Bank's scholarships program, which also aimed to support students affected by the COVID-19 crisis.

Another new initiative involved the creation of the Family Savings Observatory with the patronage of the Fundación Mutualidad Abogacía, and we also launched the IE Foundation Fellows program, centering on offering a group of very talented scholarship recipients a program of activities and personalized mentoring during their time at IE University.

I would also like to dedicate a special mention to the members of IE's International Advisory Board, such as Kofi Appenteng, who are engaged in important projects with the Foundation. We are also proud of the tradition started by René Dahan and László Kapolyi, and of the ideas and proposals that have led to outstanding projects such as the signing of a new scholarship agreement with the Mexican philanthropist Valentín Díez Morodo.

I would also like to thank the generosity of Guillermo de la Dehesa who, together with his wife Michèle Barbé, donated his impressive Economics book collection, consisting of 20,000 tomes on the subject, to the IE Library.

I would also like to honor a person with very close links to IE, Rafael Benjumea y Cabeza de Vaca, who generously dedicated his time and energy to numerous activities at the Foundation. Rafael Benjumea, who passed away this year, was an outstanding ambassador of IE Foundation's "Young Talented Leaders" program, helping to provide scholarships of over €1.7 million for exceptional students with companies such as FRV, Cubico, AJE Group and Philyra, opening the Foundation's doors to many companies and partners.

Finally, I would like to thank the Foundation's Executive Vice President, Gonzalo Garland, our Deputy Vice President, Nancy Cueto, and our General Director, Geoffroy Gérard, as well as all those who have contributed to running the Foundation, including Rafael Puyol and Carlos Mas, whom we would like to thank for their tremendous dedication, ability and hard work, which have enabled us to get where we are today.



Dear Community,

2020 was certainly a complex year, a year of resilience in which the global impact of the COVID-19 virus generated an even greater need to support talent than ever before. The generosity of IE Foundation's partners and benefactors at such an unprecedented moment in history has been unparalleled, increasing the number of scholarship programs, endorsing the different initiatives undertaken and strengthening the IE University community.

Indeed, one of IE Foundation's main challenges in 2020 was the need to expand its scholarship funds so that the brightest talent was still able to fulfill its potential. This led to the creation of the IE Resilience Scholarship Fund in conjunction with IE University. 

In 2020, IE Foundation also launched the IE Foundation Fellows program, a community of outstanding scholar-ship recipients studying undergraduate and master's degree programs. The aim of this initiative is to recognize students who are exceptional in both academic and personal terms, create a sense of belonging and commitment to the IE community, and give them the tools to become agents of change in their respective professional careers.

In addition, IE Foundation worked to further enhance the value of the prestigious IE doctoral program, developed to enable students to engage in their chosen field of research, and it continued its commitment to fostering talent and sustaining the intellectual curiosity of all students through support for the IE Library.

The different IE Centers also addressed various topics of interest, such as the role of philanthropy in society through the "Personal Philanthropy Profiles in Spain" report, drawn up by the IE Center for Families in Business in conjunction with CaixaBank Banca Privada; the relationship between innovation and diversity, through the 2019 InnoDiversity Index,

a pioneering research study that compiled key data on diversity and innovation in companies in Spain which was promoted by the IE Center for Diversity in Global Management; and the concept of customer-centricity, with the first benchmark report by the IE Center for C-Centricity, entitled "Decoding C-Centricity", which seeks to develop knowledge about what it means to be customer-centric.

In addition, new agreements were signed to promote new lines of research, such as the partnership agreement between IE Foundation and the Fundación Mutualidad Abogacía to create the Family Savings Observatory. Other agreements with strategic partners, such as JPMorgan and Mapfre, were renewed, enabling us to consolidate major initiatives such as the digital transformation of small retail businesses in the city of Madrid during the COVID-19 crisis and the third MAPFRE Foundation Awards for Social Innovation, both of which were promoted by the Center for Social Innovation and Sustainability.

Likewise, in 2020, IE Foundation participated in a number of social initiatives championing the value of the humanities and increasing their visibility, encouraging entrepreneurship and fostering student talent in our community. These included the Humanities Awards, the Hay Festival, our Social Action programs (Global Bridges and Financiers without Borders), our contribution to the South Summit, the organization of the Reinventing Higher Education Conference, support for the organization of EnlightEd and backing for student club activities via Campus Life. Through these initiatives, IE Foundation seeks to expand its outreach on and off campus, raising the profile of its actions in the IE community, and becoming more involved in supporting a community that is strongly committed to its institution and to society.







4.2 IE FOUNDATION FELLOWS

At IE Foundation, we live by our deeply held commitment to the power of "Talent Taking Care of Talent". For this reason, we direct a major part of the donations put forward by our students, alumni, parents, corporate partners, and other benefactors into scholarships.

The recipients of these scholarships are exceptional candidates with high potential for impact. With this in mind, in 2020 we decided to launch the IE Foundation Fellows program, which brings together outstanding current and past IE Foundation scholarship recipients to help channel that positive impact towards the IE Community and society at large. In its first year, the program started strong with 173 students, and now, with the Young Talented Leaders recipients also included, IE Foundation Fellows has reached an impressive amount of 240 members.

In order to find the best and brightest candidates with outstanding personal, professional and academic achievements, we conduct a rigorous selection process. Then, these Fellows receive personal guidance and support from the directors of IE Foundation, as well as access to valuable networking opportunities through activities and events organized by IE Foundation and IE University.

In return, we count on these Fellows to become dedicated mentors and ambassadors of IE. They volunteer at key IE Events in order to help us to create greater awareness of our foundation and to offer guidance and support to new students across both our Madrid and Segovia Campuses.

From tuition and accommodation to materials and medical insurance, our Young Talented Leaders are supported and empowered every step of the way.

IEU Parents for students with high potential

The families of our students and alumni have a significant impact on our community. Thanks to their support, IE Foundation is able to award two full scholarships per intake every year. These scholarships are offered to talented candidates who possess a high academic potential, influence for impact, and an entrepreneurial flair in their chosen field, but have financial barriers to higher education.

Celsia-Cubico

Cubico Sustainable Investments (Cubico) and Celsia Colombia (Celsia) have come together with IE Foundation to launch a scholarship for Colombian undergraduate students at IE University. The program is designed to support gifted Colombian students who are committed to their education and have demonstrated a strong desire to achieve personal growth, but are experiencing financial obstacles. It covers tuition fees, accommodation, academic materials, and travel expenses during a four-year degree program.



4.4 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR TALENT & EXCELLENCE

These scholarships are supported by donations from the IE community, with the express purpose of giving promising prospective students the financial assistance they need to continue their studies. They are available to anyone studying at one of IE University's five schools, including its undergraduate, master and executive education programs, and who has outstanding academic records as well as a strong social commitment.

General Scholarship Fund

The General Scholarship Fund has supported over 200 high achievers on the path to unleashing their full potential. Awards are based on each student's academic performance, social involvement and financial situation, in order to ensure that the most deserving individuals receive the help they need.

Fulbright Commission

IE Foundation has actively collaborated for years with the world-renowned Fulbright Commission to provide postgraduate students from the United States with financial support to study at IE University. The Foundation funds full-tuition scholarships for programs such as the International MBA and Master in Management, as well as degrees in communications, social and behavioral sciences and global and public affairs. These are highly competitive awards given to students who show particular academic potential and a unique drive to innovate and promote change in the world around them.


Doctorate Programs

IE Business School offers two doctoral programs: a full-time Ph.D. and a part-time DBA.

These programs are designed to attract individuals at the top of their fields, and take them to the next level academically and professionally. The Ph.D. program is limited to an intake of just ten students each year, allowing participants to receive individual attention and support as they explore ideas, conduct research, and prepare their theses. IE Foundation supports the Ph.D. program at IE University and offers several grants to cover tuition and fees, so that candidates can focus on their projects without having to worry about finances.







4.5 SANTANDER ONLINE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

In 2020, IE Foundation's collaboration with Banco Santander has continued supporting students and young professionals from all around the world through challenging times.

Early this year, the Santander-IE Digital DNA scholars completed their pioneering program, designed to boost the employability of university students by achieving digital skills in business administration, data management and digital innovation.

With the outbreak of COVID-19, the Aid to Education Fund was launched as a quick response to the needs of students, teachers and young professionals to speed up the shift to a hybrid environment at a global level. This program, which ran from March to July, offered 5,500 scholarships to higher-education students and young professionals to learn about key topics such as customer centricity, leadership in VUCA times, data science and digital transformation, among others. Moreover, the Fund also offered 10,000 additional scholarships to educators from all academic stages to take online courses about best practices on digital education.

After the summer, two more scholarship programs were launched—the Santander IE Tech4Law Program, aimed at top Law profiles willing to add new technological skills to their professional development, and the Santander IE Tech Revolution in Finance Program, designed to show the potential of the financial environment to students and young professionals with STEM profiles.

In addition to this, IE Foundation also sought to support Spanish homegrown talent by collaborating with Santander Bank and Tresmares Capital in the launch of the Tresmares Scholarships. This program covers 70% of tuition for any of IE University's Executive Education courses and is aimed specifically at managers from high-growth potential SMEs, who thanks to these scholarships have the opportunity to be an active part in their companies' growth by furthering their knowledge of management and leadership, digital transformation, sales, and marketing.

4.6 SPOTLIGHT ON THE IE RESILIENCE SCHOLARSHIP FUND (COVID-19)

The events of the last 12 months prompted the creation of the IE Resilience Scholarship Fund (COVID-19). The program, which is funded by both the IE Foundation and IE University, is focused on supporting academic pursuits of outstanding current and future students who have been impacted by the global pandemic.

The fund is aimed specifically at students and future applicants from vulnerable sectors of society in areas of the world most affected by the global health crisis. 4.7 IE WOMEN INITIATIVE

The IE Women Initiative works to support and promote women in business, technology, and entrepreneurship. IE faculty, researchers, student clubs, alumni and staff design the tools and programs that will most effectively attract, retain, and bolster talented women in their pursuit of professional advancement and success. Thanks to the IE community and its donors, IE Foundation backs this initiative, directing a significant portion of its budget exclusively to supporting women on their unique path to success.

Women in Business Club

The IE Women in Business Club is a network that's open to both IE students and alumni. Their goal is to provide resources and networking opportunities for anyone with an interest in promoting gender equality in business. With undergraduate and postgraduate chapters at the Segovia and Madrid campuses, they hold a number of dinners and events to address gender issues in professional settings.

Scholarships for Women

As part of its mission to further diversity at the university, IE Foundation makes available more than 10 scholarships for high-potential women to unlock their talents. These include the SheTrades Scholarship, Women Leadership Award, and Women in STEM Scholarship, among others.

With support from donors and the IE Community at large, these scholarships ensure that ambitious, high-achieving women aren't held back from reaching their goals due to financial restrictions. In total, this fund represents an investment of almost nine million euros, a resource that helps future female leaders gain the skills for a lifetime of success.

International Women's Week

To celebrate International Women's Day 2020, a week of events addressing gender equality were held across our Madrid and Segovia campuses. The sessions included topic-oriented lunches, book signings, the Women in Business Club's Annual Conference: Leading Forward, a visit to a museum, and mentoring sessions for undergraduate students. In contrast to previous years, there was an immense amount of student participation with interesting discussions on some of the most important issues affecting women in business and the workplace.

Training

In collaboration with the IE Women in Business Club, the Diversity Center supports IE's female alum club, IE Women in Business, in a mentoring program that aims to provide young IE students, currently enrolled in master's programs, with the opportunity to receive mentoring support to help them in their professional careers.

There are also a number of mentoring programs for female students to help women in mid-level positions gain access to top leadership roles, in addition to the Women Strategy Lab, a project which aims to empower female talent in strategic consulting.

qualitative analysis of more than 50 hours of interviews with relevant philanthropists in the country, experts and foundation managers, in an effort to better understand the reality of philanthropy.



5.1 SPOTLIGHT ON: 2020 COLLABORATIVE INITIATIVES



Profiles of Personal Philanthropy in Spain



CaixaBank Banca Privada

On September 29, 2020, the IE Center For Families In Business published the report *Profiles of Personal Philanthropy in Spain*. The center's mission is to contribute to the development and impact of family businesses, helping these companies and their stake-holders to build the values and mindset that will help them tackle future challenges.

The report, conducted in collaboration with CaixaBank Banca Privada, involved analyzing more than 50 hours of interviews with notable Spanish philanthropists in order to better understand the nature of philanthropy. It emerged that, beyond generosity and altruism, the philanthropist acts as a leader of a greater project of social transformation.



Coca-Cola Europacific Partners

In 2020, the report *Promoting the entrepreneurial spirit* of talent was developed, the second installment of a collaboration agreement between IE University, IE Foundation and Coca-Cola Europacific Partners. The collaboration aims to contribute to society and its development, and to the business world and academia, with leading knowledge on today's most relevant topics.

The study's primary objective is to understand which policies of labor organization and human resources management help create an environment that encourages the entrepreneurial spirit of mid-level managers to flourish. It reveals which organizational and management practices promote managers' innovation and intrapreneurship within mature companies.

The study surveyed 500 managers at companies with more than 200 employees in Spain across different sectors. It was published in April 2021.

The Household Savings Observatory

In May 2020, IE Foundation launched the Household Savings Observatory in collaboration with the Fundación Mutualidad Abogacía. Through data collection on family savings in both the medium- and long-term, the Observatory hopes to achieve two objectives.

Firstly, it aims to develop an awareness in Spanish society of the importance of saving and financial planning, the barriers that prevent certain households from saving, and how to overcome these obstacles.

Secondly, it strives to provide knowledge and insights that can help financial institutions and authorities to promote a culture of saving, design policies and strategies to promote responsible saving, and develop a more equal economic distribution of savings across society.

The initiative also includes a scholarship for doctoral or post-doctoral research to further develop this important work.


At the beginning of the year, IE Foundation, J.P. Morgan, the City Council of Madrid, and Orange joined forces to promote digitalization for small businesses in Madrid in a bid to mitigate the impact of the COVID-19 crisis on the economy.

Digital transformation is key to helping small businesses survive the fall-out of the pandemic, ensuring they can reach as many customers as possible. The initiative focused on those neighborhoods most severely impacted by the crisis, giving 70 Madrid-based businesses the opportunity to build their digital strategy through training and personalized support.

This initiative contributes to IE Foundation's general mission to promote business leadership and an entrepreneurial mindset, driving innovation and change and contributing to local communities.

3rd Edition of the Fundación MAPFRE Awards for Social Innovation, promoted by IE Foundation

Last year's Fundación MAPFRE Awards for Social Innovation—an initiative designed to support innovative solutions with the potential for large-scale social impact—took place virtually on October 10, 2020.



The awards fall into three categories: e-health, insurance innovation, and mobility and road safety.

The initiative, promoted by the IE Center for Social Innovation & Sustainability, aims to support social innovation in communities across Latin America and Europe, focusing on those projects with the greatest capacity for social transformation. The awards held special relevance in the context of the pandemic, a time of constant uncertainty that demands innovative solutions.

Following regional semifinals in Mexico City, São Paulo, and Madrid—and with the help of expert mentors and coaches—the nine finalists presented their projects in Madrid. The jury selected three winners, one for each category, and they each received €30,000 to promote their project.

Center for Social Innovation & Sustainability

Providing educational content, conducting pivotal research, and establishing meaningful partnerships with other forward-thinking organizations, the Center for Social Innovation & Sustainability plays a key role in IE Foundation's mission to equip tomorrow's leaders with an entrepreneurial spirit and a global vision.

2020 saw the center help with the organization and promotion of the third edition of the Fundación MAPFRE Awards for Social Innovation. €30,000 was awarded to three finalists to help them develop their projects in the categories of e-health, insurance

innovation, and mobility and road safety. The projects were chosen from more than 200 initiatives submitted by participants across Latin America and Europe.

The event concluded with the launch of the fourth edition of the awards.

Meanwhile, the Digital Transformation and Inclusive Business Development project, first launched in 2018, continued its work supporting small businesses in Madrid, many of which needed additional assistance following the COVID-19 crisis. With support from J.P. Morgan, Madrid City Council, and Orange, 70 small businesses in those neighborhoods hit hardest by the pandemic were given the opportunity to develop their digital strategy, including learning how to implement online stores and optimize their online presence.

The center is also involved in research being undertaken for case studies on purpose-driven companies as part of a collaboration with Secretaría General Iberoamericana (SEGIB) and IE Law School. This ambitious international initiative seeks to create a new regulatory ecosystem for companies and businesses to balance financial success with social and environmental impact. The project is intended to assist Ibero-American governments in their efforts to contribute to the UN's Sustainable Development Goals.

Open Conference: Decoding C-Centricity—February 2020

Center for C-Centricity

IE's Center for C-Centricity was launched at the beginning of the 2018-19 academic year. Its goal is to promote customer, consumer, and citizen centricity, balancing satisfying human experiences with sustainable business growth.

In its bid to highlight the importance of C-Centricity, the center published a report titled *Decoding Customer Centricity*, demonstrating how organizations need to completely rethink the way they operate—from work culture to metrics of success—if they are to fully embrace customer centricity. The report's findings were presented at an in-person event organized in collaboration with PwC in March 2020.

The center continued to hold discussion forums and think tanks throughout 2020 with contributing speakers such as Zia Zaman, innovator, author, and CEO of Beaver Lake Capital, and Scott Anthony, senior partner at Innosight.

The center's corporate partners also got involved with several educational projects at IE. Repsol, one of the center's members, was selected by the International MBA as their partner for the Business Impact Lab. On the other hand, 24 professionals from the center's member companies participated in Decoding Customer &

Consumer Centricity, the center's Executive Education program.

The Center is also investigating and generating insights into the concept of C-Centricity by means of an evaluation tool called the 'C-Centricity Monitor'. This tool is an annual study and public report based on a quantitative survey of a wide range of companies.

Carlos Mas, Chairman of IE Center for C-Centricity, also acted as a moderator in a roundtable at the third Senior Economy Forum, a pioneering think tank about the role of senior citizens in the economy.

The Center is fueled by a rich a diverse group of corporate partners that contribute with their vision and expertise helping to advance C-Centricity knowledge.

ANNUAL REPORT 2020

IE Center for Families in Business

As part of the center's mission to help and support entrepreneurial families, a number of initiatives took place over 2020 to develop knowledge on how family businesses are operating in the current climate. Many of these activities had the support of leading companies including: Banca March, CaixaBank Banca Privada, Coca-Cola Europacific Partners, EY, Fundación Botín and Luiss Business School.

For instance, there was a virtual meeting on innovation in family business organized by the Catalan Family Business Association (ASCEF) and with the support of EY Global. The event included a presentation by Cristina Cruz, Academic Director of the IE Center for Families in Business, on how the challenges of innovation are different for family businesses compared to non-family businesses.

Cristina Cruz also became a Fellow in the Family Firm Institute (FFI) in 2020.

The center also worked on several research projects in 2020. For instance, it published a report in collaboration with CaixaBank Banca Privada that explores the nature of personal philanthropy in Spain. It also carried out a project alongside Coca-Cola Europacific Partners on how to best promote the entrepreneurial spirit in professionals, which was published in April 2021.


Finally, the center developed research projects alongside EY, Banca March and Fundación Botín on topics spanning innovation, entrepreneurship, sustainability and the creative economy.

Another of the center's initiatives was the Global Family Business Management Program, which was organized in collaboration with IE Business School, Luiss Business School in Rome, and IESEG School of Management in Lille. The program helped 18 international students to better understand and identify opportunities for sustainable growth while maintaining cohesion within family businesses.

Finally, the IE Center for Families in Business also accompanied international families through their challenges by applying the Family Journey format. Involving various counseling and support activities, this advisory service was tailored to each unique family business.

Center for Diversity in Global Management

IE Foundation's Center for Diversity in Global Management was created to promote diversity in gender, culture, age and abilities, and to re-envision diversity as a competitive advantage in the corporate world, offering training, conducting research, and participating in the international conversation about diversity. The center also develops research on gender through the GAPI, a digital tool created to identify unconscious gender bias.

The center seeks to spread awareness about diversity through initiatives such as the Árbol de la InnoDiversidad index, a three-year project sponsored by Pfizer and HP. This index for measuring innovation and diversity within companies allows businesses to better manage diversity.

In addition, there is the Gestión de la Diversidad en Telefónica (*Diversity Management at Telefónica*), a year-long applied research program that seeks to understand how corporate diversity management can improve resilience, innovation, and efficacy within teams.

The center's research activity also includes the Observatory of Demography and Generational Diversity, which is an initiative to research the fundamental demographic questions of our society. Its latest research was coordinated by the center and the IE Center for Social Innovation and Sustainability, and sponsored by Mapfre, Correos and the Santander Foundation.

The 2020-2021 edition of the IE Women Mentoring Program began in December 2020 in collaboration with the IE Women in Business Club, the American Chamber of Commerce in Spain (AMCHAM) and the CFA Society Spain—Women in Finance Committee. The program is a unique opportunity for IE high-potential women students to extend their learning with the support of expert mentors outside the classroom and beyond.

UTES Event March 2020

Center for Transport Economics & Infrastructure Management

With support from IE Foundation, as well as high-level companies in the global transport and infrastructure industries, this center continued its work examining those issues affecting transportation and infrastructure, carrying out activities, holding seminars, and conducting reports to expand awareness about this important sector.

In March 2020, the center held an in-person conference to assess the advantages and challenges posed by UTEs, or temporary business alliances.

From July to October and in various cities across Spain, a series of events were organized to celebrate the 169th edition of *Revista Economistas*, the quarterly magazine published by Madrid's Colegio de Economistas. The events welcomed guests as esteemed as city mayors, leading economists and experts in transportation and infrastructure, all gathered to discuss the topic of the edition's focus: the future of mobility in cities.

MITMA Workshop—November 2020

Two virtual events also took place focusing on the future of train travel. In April, there was the Rail Live! webinar series, which focused on how technology can build a sustainable and intelligent mobility ecosystem. And in October, there was *Virtual Africa Rail*, which focused on Africa's train and transport industry.

November saw yet other virtual workshops in collaboration with Deloitte and MITMA (Ministry of Transport, Mobility, and Urban Agenda). This last collaboration brought an event centered on the draft law concerning sustainable mobility and transportation financing, with a speech by María José Rallo del Olmo, General Secretary for Transportation and Mobility.

Saudi-Spanish Center for Islamic Economics and Finance (SCIEF)

The Saudi-Spanish Center for Islamic Economics and Finance (SCIEF) is recognized worldwide as a hub for the study and promotion of Islamic finance, which is based on an alternative and ethical financial system.

Throughout 2020, SCIEF worked on the fifth edition of the SCIEF book series, entitled *Islamic Fintech*. This book contributes to the discussion by focusing on a specific dimension of this phenomenon not yet sufficiently covered: the influence of new technologies on Islamic finance. The edition was published in January 2021.

SCIEF also developed the Islamic Finance Changemakers Challenge, a new competition in partnership with the Islamic Development Bank, with more than \$30,000 USD in prizes. The competition aims to build a global movement where anyone, anywhere, can take action to solve a social problem in their community. SCIEF works to build this movement by supporting social entrepreneurs, innovators, business leaders and policy makers by delivering groundbreaking analysis, accelerating entrepreneurship and creating strong partnerships that will drive the movement forward.

During 2020, SCIEF also organized a series of webinars focusing on post-pandemic finance. The #SCIEFtalks series was held online with expert speakers discussing subjects related to Islamic finance.

The SCIEF General Coordinator Gonzalo Rodríguez also presented the State of the Global Islamic Economy (SGIE) Report at a launch event in November for Spanish-speaking countries. The SGIE, produced annually, has become the global reference for executives, investors, and economic development experts in the Islamic/Halal industry.

Africa Solutions, Global Challenges, Lagos 2019



Africa Center

The primary goal of all initiatives at the Africa Center is to transform the way global executives consider African innovation.

By promoting a more Africa-centric view of business and society and by partnering with African innovators and pioneering institutions—including those across the diaspora—the center brings an African perspective to global conversations on social innovation.

In 2020, the center held the fourth edition of its flagship event, *African Solutions, Global Challenges,* in partnership with London's SOAS University, the African Foundation for Development, and the MIT Legatum Center for Development and Entrepreneurship. The series of short TED-style talks focused on the role of the African diaspora in shaping the continent's present and future.

Throughout the year, the center organized a series of webinars entitled *Building Resilience in Difficult Times*. One of the webinars included special guest Patrice Juah, author, editor and IE Kistefos Scholar.

The center also collaborated with the IE Africa Club on the IE Virtual Africa Business Conference which took place in May 2020.

The Social Innovators Retreat was designed to foster unique knowledge generation for Africa's leading innovators who wish to scale up their projects through new tools, ideas and partners. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the exclusive event was put on pause, but the hope is for it to return in 2021.

The IE Africa Center continued the Africa Lab, a virtual residency program focused on identifying those African entrepreneurs whose business idea has particular potential, supporting their development through storytelling, market research, data analytics, and by helping them to find opportunities in the European market.

China Center

By promoting Chinese business models and practices, the IE China Center seeks to spread understanding of the market potential represented by China, develop an international network of Chinese companies, and attract more Chinese talent and faculty members to Spain.

The center's achievements this year include the report, *Understanding Chinese Family Businesses: The Path, The Trends, The Future,* which tracks more than 300 family businesses in 20 different industry categories over a period of five years.





Together with Cheung-Kong Graduate School of Business, the center presented this report in a webinar in November 2020. Carlos Mas, President of the IE Center for Families in Business, contributed with his article "Families in Business: A Bright Future in Europe and China," in which he examines the similarities and differences between the two regions when it comes to family companies.

IE-Elecnor Observatory on Sustainable Compliance Cultures


This Observatory was created to promote a culture of sustainable compliance in medium-scale Spanish businesses by assisting them in their risk assessment, prevention and control measures. Through extensive research and studies, the Observatory aims to create awareness of the ethical principles and expectations that different interest groups have when it comes to social and environmental issues.

On November 23rd, the Observatory launched its website—an essential step in spreading awareness about its activities, values and goals. This included the publication of diverse articles and practical worksheets empowering companies and organizations to implement and enforce higher standards of compliance.

The Observatory also worked on the development of a report on the culture of sustainable compliance in Spanish SMEs throughout 2020, which will be published in 2021.

Observatory of Demography and Generational Diversity

The Center for Social Innovation & Sustainability collaborated with the IE Center for Diversity on a third research report carried out by the Observatory for Generational Diversity, whose work seeks to expose the socioeconomic implications of age diversity in the workplace.

This third report is titled *Intergeneracionalidad:* oportunidad de innovación para la empresa y la sociedad (Intergenerationality: Innovation Opportunities for Business and Society) and will be presented in June 2021.

In 2020, the Observatory of Demography and Generational Diversity made an online presentation of its second report. Titled *Senior Workers in European Companies*, the report is focused on how age, as a diversity variable, affects company culture and environment. Analysis of those companies in the report highlights exactly what diversity means for the future of work.

Among other insights, the report highlights an increase of 11.5 million senior workers from 2008 to 2017 in the nine European countries analyzed. The report looks at demographic variables, labor laws regarding senior workers and good business practices in countries in northern, central and southern Europe.

Household Savings Observatory

Established in May 2020 as a collaboration between IE Foundation and Fundación Mutualidad Abogacía, the Household Savings Observatory seeks to promote a culture of saving among Spanish families and provide the necessary knowledge to allow financial institutions and authorities to design policies and strategies to encourage responsible saving.

In 2020, the Observatory launched a report on the resilience and vulnerability of families across six European countries (Spain, Germany, France, Italy, Portugal and Belgium) during the COVID-19 pandemic. The initiative aimed to form a profound understanding of families' economic behavior in order to encourage debate on the best measures to take to promote a culture of financial health in the regions analyzed.

The study enjoyed widespread national coverage after its release—it was written about in El País, and the Observatory's director, Laura Núñez, was invited to discuss it on the Spanish television program *Madrid Directo*.

The authors examine ambiguity around terms such as customer and consumer, explore what customer centricity is not, and create a clear and applicable definition of customer centricity for companies to apply in the workplace.

Working together with IE Law School students, it also conducts research, such as the Independent Study Cervelló.

In November, the Chair chose the winner of the XIV Cervelló Award on the theme of "Freedom of Expression and Its Limits in an Interconnected World." Juan Albero Valdés won with "Freedom of Expression in the Face of Algorithmic Society: A Look at the Problem of Online Content Moderation."

Seed Funds

IE Foundation's seed funds are an opportunity for faculty members to conduct research to further elevate their teaching. These seed funds provide them with resources to investigate and develop new methods and practices. Such projects are a compelling addition to the standard curriculum.

The initiative is also designed to allow professors to attend conferences both at home and abroad, so they can present their ideas, research, and solutions in person. Knowing they have the support of IE Foundation, faculty members are more motivated to undertake research and share this excitement and enthusiasm with students.

True innovation requires networking, collaboration, and relationship-building.

In its Research Forums, which are held on campus, IE Foundation brings together the most innovative researchers from around the world, allowing the IE community to hear the world's most high-level leaders and future-focused thinkers present their findings.

By promoting an interdisciplinary exchange of ideas, concepts, research, and data, we are rejecting the notion of business as one that is inherently competitive, instead fostering an environment of collaboration.

In 2020, IE Foundation's Seed Funds initiative allowed 95 instructors from different IE schools to start research, helping them to acquire the necessary equipment, carry out surveys, experiments, and data analysis, and participate in virtual conferences.

5.7 THE IE LIBRARY

The IE Library plays an essential role in knowledge creation and promotion, providing services and resources for the entire academic community as well as the wider public. By embracing new technological tools, the library could continue to offer an exceptional service throughout the pandemic.




Throughout 2020, the library improved its virtual and digital profile with new website functionalities, such as accessibility settings to make the website more inclusive and personal (allowing users to choose the colors, fonts, and content), as well as an Events and Trends section to highlight relevant news.

To that end, the library also played an important role in IE's shift to Liquid Learning, the state-of-the-art teaching methodology that blends online and face-to-face education for one seamless experience. In a context in which students need both high-quality online resources and physical resources, the IE Library was a crucial source of support.

All initiatives led by IE Library are created with sustainability in mind, and the library is actively contributing to and participating in the IFLA Programs on Advocacy and Global Vision within the framework of the UN's Sustainable Development Goals.

Another initiative, Purple Corner, was named among the 'Best Practices from World Libraries' list by the American Library Association in 2020. Purple Corner was designed to promote available resources and information related to preventing gender violence and promoting equality. Any IE Community member can recommend relevant books or articles through the initiative.



Thanks to the generous support of donors and partners, IE Foundation is able to undertake initiatives and lead projects with the aim of delivering significant social impact and promoting positive social change.



This extracurricular department is pivotal in helping students work with and support their community, as well as in allowing them to develop their capacity for open and non-judgmental communication and exchange.




The theme of this year's event was Reimagine Economic Inclusion, and conversations focused on what steps need to be taken to ensure that, in the race for business growth, no one is left behind. This event was part of the Sustainability Week, which is organized by

IE Campus Life and the Sustainability Office, and

was included in the overarching theme The Big Reset, addressing the three pillars of the Sustainable Development Goals: Economic, Social, and Environmental Inclusion.

Additionally, the club participated in the IE Virtual 6K, a race that took place via the Strava app. The event was organized to raise money for those communities where women and children are forced to walk six kilometers a day to fetch water and was held in partnership with Thirst Project, a non-profit organization providing water solutions to developing countries.

Finally, the Islamic Finance Changemakers Challenge was organized to support social entrepreneurs, innovators and business leaders seeking to implement social change via Islamic financial solutions. The winning entry received \$15,000 and access to a 1-year IE University mentoring program.









LGBT@Work

In July 2020, IE Foundation sponsored the annual LGBT@Work Conference, run by the IE Out and Allies Club, which promotes LGBT+ leadership in business.

Speakers at the conference included Phyll Opoku-Gyimah, aka Lady Phyll, executive director and co-founder of UK Black Pride, as well as Linda Aiello, executive vice president of employee success at Salesforce; Amanda McKay, quality director for the major projects business within Balfour Beatty; and Suresh Raj, chief business development officer at Vision7 International, part of BlueFocus International.

The event is the third-largest business school LGBT+ conference in the world and can also claim to be the longest-running in Europe, offering an inspirational platform for dialogue around diversity and inclusivity and fostering connection between the university and major companies.

Women in Leadership Conference Leading Forward

In March 2020, the IE Women in Business Club organized the 4th Women in Leadership Conference on the theme Leading Forward. With a range of speakers and panelists from across diverse industries, the focus of the half-day conference was on empowering attendees to understand what successful leadership looks like.

Discussions centered on the important issues affecting the modern workplace, and women in particular, including how men can be allies in gender equality initiatives, cross-cultural perceptions of gender equality, and alternative definitions of success.

Wide-ranging perspectives came from a host of speakers from around the world, including Nathalie Picquot, CEO of Twitter Spain & Portugal and board member of Inspiring Girls; as well as Teresa Martín-Retortillo, executive president at IE Exponential Learning. The conference was followed by an after-party, offering attendees the opportunity to network directly with speakers, corporate sponsors, and other guests.

Africa Day 2020

In May 2020, the IE Africa Club held its 9th annual Africa Business Conference, focusing on the theme *Rethink Doing Business in Africa*. Speakers explored how businesses in Africa are undergoing a radical transformation and, specifically, how the Information and Communications Technology and Industry sectors are changing.

Industry leaders and experts talked about important topics, including how businesses in Africa might look like post-COVID-19 and what opportunities in the ICT and Industry sectors seem to be the most promising for the next decade.

Chinese New Year 2020

While the pandemic prevented the IE Community's typical Chinese New Year celebrations from being held, the IE China Club gathered to film a video in support of Wuhan, the first city affected by the pandemic. The club continues to organize events and initiatives, including an online panel talk on the subject *A new era of healthcare in China: post-pandemic transformation*.

Together with the IE Pharma and Healthcare Club, the event focused on the major issues faced by the healthcare industry, including digital health, artificial intelligence, wearable devices, and how COVID-19 is encouraging technology-driven transformations. Speaker Annelie Qu, an attending ENT physician and a CBL certificate holder from Emlyon Business School, shared her studies and first-hand experiences of healthcare in China.



Global Village

The 14th edition of the Global Village Day, organized by the IE Net Impact Club in collaboration with Campus Life and one of IE University's most valued traditions, offered a renewed commitment to and celebration of diversity—an essential value on a campus where over 130 nationalities are represented.

While COVID-19 prevented some of the usual activities from happening, the organizers were able to adapt and reinvent the experience virtually. New initiatives included the launch of the weekly Global Village Recipe Series, published in the Campus Life Newsletter, and a Global Village Video, featuring songs and speeches from members of the IE Community and footage from previous Global Village celebrations.

Wuha Sira Initiative

This non-profit organization based in Ethiopia was launched by IE University professor Gayle Allard and provides water access and educational opportunities for young women.

IE Foundation has been supporting the organization's initiatives for over half a decade with annual grants to fund a local startup that provides clean and safe water to the city of Dilla.

These initiatives not only help protect residents against diseases, but also frees women and children from the task of collecting water, allowing them to attend school instead. Wuha Sira also funds scholarships for girls to attend private schools in Dilla as well as programs to feed the families most impacted by COVID-19.



South Summit is an event created by Spain Startup and co-organized by IE University with the goal of establishing the country as a hub for entrepreneurship, as well as showcasing the talent and creativity emerging from startups in southern Europe, the Mediterranean, and Latin America.

IE Foundation's central objective is to foster social entrepreneurship and innovation. Supporting the South Summit allows the foundation to assist innovators from disadvantaged communities to enter into international business and to expand this thriving network of entrepreneurs.

South Summit 2020—the most international South Summit event to date—took place in October and focused on the challenges facing the entrepreneurial ecosystem post-pandemic. Over 30,000 people attended from 135+ nationalities, and more than 7,700 of them were entrepreneurs. The virtual three-day international event took place on a multi-channel digital platform and provided opportunities for attendees to connect and network with key players in international business.

Each day saw presentations from the most innovative startups in categories ranging from health and wellbeing and education to sustainability and fintech. There was also exclusive content from speakers such as Eric S. Yuan, founder and CEO of Zoom; Carlos Sainz, two-time world rally champion and three-time

Rally Dakar winner; former NASA astronaut Cady Coleman; Teach for All CEO Wendy Kopp; Iridium COO Suzi Mcbrie, and award-winning Spanish actor Antonio Banderas among others.

This year's summit continued to build and develop the relationship between Spain and countries that are often left out of the global business conversation, maximizing the visibility of pioneering entrepreneurs from around the world and enhancing the outlook of the industry with an influx of new perspectives and ideas. More than 2,100 investors attended, with an estimated investment portfolio of \$130B.

6.3 THE FUTURE OF HIGHER EDUCATION



Reinventing Higher Education Conference

The Reinventing Higher Education Conference is held annually to provide a platform for university administrators, policymakers, entrepreneurs, business professionals, academics, student representatives and media figures to discuss the state of higher education both today and in the future.

In 2020, Santiago Iñiguez, president of IE University, kickstarted a joint statement highlighting the necessity for universities to preserve all forms of international academic mobility in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic. 25 university presidents from over 20 countries joined and co-signed the statement "Mobility in higher education as a catalyst for resilience and renewal," coming together on June 29th for an online exchange on this crucial topic for the sector.

The international panel of speakers included Fadlo R. Khuri, president of the American University of Beirut; Ignacio Sánchez Díaz, president of the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile; Lily Kong, president of Singapore Management University; Peter Mathieson, principal and vice-chancellor of the University of Edinburgh; and Julio Frenk, president of the University of Miami.

As addressed during the event, the pandemic offers an opportunity to re-assert the importance of cross-border knowledge sharing while also reshaping the concept of academic mobility to ensure greater emphasis on inclusivity and sustainability.

Additionally, on November 17th, IE University hosted the event "Reinventing Higher Education: New Realities, New Visions for Higher Education," an online conference that explored the recent challenges and the consequences of COVID-19 for higher education models. They stressed the need for universities to continue to serve as intellectual anchors both for students and society as a whole, as well as examining what the pandemic might mean for international academic mobility in the future.

Other topics discussed included the opportunities presented by private-public initiatives and different financial models, questions around sustainability and how universities might serve as agents of change. While confronting the very real challenges facing international education at this time, the event was nevertheless optimistic with speakers able to exchange ideas and suggest new lines of action.



EnlightED 2020

EnlightED

The inaugural virtual edition of enlightED, the annual world conference on education, technology, and innovation, was held in October 2020. This five-day event, which was organized by Fundación Telefónica, IE University, Fundación Santillana, and South Summit, attracted a total of 46,000 attendees from no less than 46 countries.

The opening address was delivered by Pedro Sánchez, Prime Minister of Spain, who reiterated government's unwavering commitment to educational reform and modernization in the coming years. He also contemplated the important lessons learned as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, in particular the pressing need to bolster the Spanish welfare state.



The third iteration of the conference provided a space for over 90 intellectuals, experts and policymakers at both a national and international level to openly analyze the ways in which the pandemic has transformed education on a global scale and, ultimately, brought about the implementation of innovative educational practices in unprecedented timeframes.

Leading industry figures such as Salman Khan, Rose Luckin, Andreas Schleicher, Hadi Partovi and Rebecca Winthrop reflected on the multiple educational challenges and opportunities brought about as a result of the global health crisis. They also addressed the importance of tackling the digital skills gap postpandemic and building a future-ready workforce.

6.4 FINANCIERS WITHOUT BORDERS

Financiers without Borders, or *Financieros sin Fronteras (FsF)*, is a non-profit organization within IE Foundation.

A collaborative initiative between educators and students enrolled in the Master in Finance program at IE University, it aims to improve financial inclusivity by supporting microfinance projects in Africa.

FsF has formed a relationship with certain microfinance initiatives in Ghana, including collaborations with four different microfinance institutions in the country during 2020. Teams of students and professors provided pro bono technical assistance to these microfinance institutions aiming to help them improve before attracting international financing to boost their reach and reduce the extreme poverty in the country.

Inevitably, COVID-19 caused major disruption in Ghana. Foreign investment flows slowed, exports and imports declined, and, within the financial sector, there was a decreased demand for credit, a deterioration in the quality of loan portfolios due to poor commercial activity and cash flow challenges for microentrepreneurs.

A reduction in repayments, interest payments and ancillary income from account openings also led to a decrease in income.


FsF has been exploring ways it can help and support these projects during this time. With priorities for the microfinance sector evolving rapidly, FsF had to adapt plans accordingly. Online interviews with the micro-finance institutions were organized instead of in-person visits to Ghana, and students were still able to provide the institutions with plans and recommendations. They then presented their reports to a panel of judges who evaluated their projects before obtaining final grades for their master's work.





6.5 PUENTES GLOBAL

Puentes Global is an organization committed to making entrepreneurship more accessible. By providing training initiatives, assistance, and advice for budding entrepreneurs from disadvantaged backgrounds or facing difficult circumstances and supporting those organizations on a similar mission, Puentes Global strives to make business more inclusive.



While the pandemic presented numerous obstacles for Puentes Global in carrying out the activities it had planned, the organization was still able to continue its work in some cases, including the Capstone and Impact projects.

Between January and June 2020, the director of Puentes Global served as a mentor for various capstone projects. The organization also carried out six consulting projects as part of the Impact Project, together with the help of around 20 students.

Then there was the Skillsbuild project with IBM, a company that has been supporting Puentes Global for a few years now, and who invited PG to participate in its training platform. The organization was tasked with publishing educational content that could help users understand issues around employability, entrepreneurship and micro-business management.

During 2020, Puentes Global also collaborated with various public education centers, providing students with support on issues of employability and entrepreneurship.



6.6 SPOTLIGHT ON: THE HUMANITIES



Prizes in the Humanities

A celebration of the best written and audiovisual work created by students and staff that year, the Prizes in the Humanities are a recognition of excellence in short story and essay writing, poetry, video and photography, both in Spanish and English.

The awards encourage artistic expression, foster critical thinking and promote a creative and dynamic outlook among the IE Community.

The jury is made up of leading figures in the arts, as well as humanities professors and representatives from IE Foundation. In 2020, these included Indian writer Namita Gokhale, British journalist Tom Burns, and Spanish journalists Bieito Rubido and Carlos de Vega.


The event was held online in September 2020. From more than 700 entries spanning five different award categories, the judges picked out the winners whose work was then published in print as a celebration of their success.

Hay Festival

In September 2020, IE University co-hosted 18 events at the Hay Festival Segovia as part of its enduring support for the festival, to which it has contributed for eleven consecutive years.

During its 15th edition, the Hay Festival Segovia hosted 145 renowned opinion leaders and held 50 different events from September 17th to 20th. IE University's Aula Magna was a main venue for the festival, and the events were also streamed online so that those unable to attend in person could enjoy the discussions.

Speakers included Juan López de Uralde, congressman, former director of Greenpeace Spain and president of the Congressional Ecological Transition Committee; Jocelyn Bleriot, executive officer of the Ellen MacArthur Foundation; Isabela del Alcázar, director of sustainability at IE University; and internationally renowned US Landscape Architect Kathryn Gustafson.

Also taking part in the festival were ambassadors from Colombia, Morocco and Ireland; princes Hussain Aga Khan and Lorenzo de'Medici; authors Edurne Portela, Janne Teller, Karolina Ramqvist, Fernando Savater, Adam Michnick, Miquel Molina, and Jean Paul Dubois; designers Stephan Janson and Sybilla; nature experts Joaquín Araújo, Fernando Caruncho, Cristina Castel, and Sofia Barroso; and journalists Enric Juliana, Manuel Carvalho, Francesco Olivo, and René Moerland, among others.

6.7 DIVERSITY & IMPACT

Índice El Árbol de la Innodiversidad (Innodiversity Index)

This three-year project is led by the IE Center for Diversity in Global Management and sponsored by Pfizer and HP. The project involves an index of innodiversity based on a definition of innodiversity as the organizational capacity to manage diversity and innovation in order to improve overall business competitiveness.

By means of the project's self-diagnostic tool, Spanish companies will be able to assess their own innodiversity. The report on the first set of results was presented in September 2020.



Gestión de la Diversidad en Telefónica (Diversity Management at Telefónica)

This one-year applied research program, also led by the IE Center for Diversity in Global Management, aims to expand understanding of how diversity management can improve overall business performance in terms of resilience, innovation and the effectiveness of teams. Together with the Innodiversity Index, this project will map a new path for corporations for managing diversity within teams.



6.8 IE FOUNDATION SPONSORSHIPS






