Beyond these traditional academic criteria, we seek academics with the capacity to engage in policy relevant work, and with a commitment to institution-building: applying for research grants, participating in affiliated research centers and academic programs, and expanding the IE's current network and partnerships.

Applications should include a cover letter indicating the job market conferences they are attending, a vita, a job market paper, three academic references, and evidence of teaching excellence (e.g. teaching evaluations).
