


Unbound Selves

The Essence of You


Your identity is the meeting point of two worlds: between how you see yourself in the world and the quieter world that lives inside you.

You are invited to feel the outlines of a self still forming, an identity defined not by clarity, but by what resists being seen (the Unseen) and by the way your perception of the world showed you how to perform (the Seen).

This exhibition brings together artworks from the **Fundación ARCO Collection** in dual pairs, each chosen to symbolize a specific tension between opposing identity conditions. Each pair is split across the two walls of the room, with one work on the Seen wall and its counterpart directly opposite on the Unseen wall.



The Seen wall represents our ego-bound, word reflecting performance of identity



The Unseen wall shows the raw, shifting and intuitive identity within us.

Inhabiting the middle space where identity takes form, we are constantly held between these two conditions in our search for authenticity.

As you move through the space and encounter your own reflection, the exhibition leaves one question open: where do you stand between what you reveal and what you keep inside, and is there really a side to pick?

Where do you stand between the Seen and the Unseen?
