**Current travel alert: Storm Filomena Aftermath – Madrid**  
Ground transport disruption

The aftermath of heavy snowfall continues to disrupt business and ground transportation in Madrid. As the snow melts in the coming days, flooding may cause further disruption. The routes of some rail services are delayed, and operations at Madrid-Barajas Adolfo Suárez Airport (MAD) are gradually resuming at terminals T1, T4 & T4S on the road to recovery.

- Check the status of your planned ground route.
- Allow for extra time.
- Consider telecommuting to avoid crowding of public transport.
- Consult your travel company/airline/rail service regarding trip status.
